Service Agreements Outlines the terms under which one party provides services to another.	Supply Agreements Sets out the terms for the supply of goods or services between a supplier and a buyer.	Confidentiality Agreements (NDAs) Ensures that sensitive information shared between parties remains confidential.
Partnership Agreements Governs the relationship, roles, and responsibilities of partners in a business partnership. A LLP agreement is similar and is used for a limited liability partnership.	Shareholders' Agreements Regulates the rights and obligations of shareholders in a company.	Franchise Agreements Allows one party (the franchisee) to operate a business under the branding and systems of another (the franchisor).
Distribution Agreements Authorises a distributor to sell products on behalf of a supplier.	Agency Agreements Establishes terms for one party (the agent) to act on behalf of another (the principal).	Joint Venture Agreements Details the terms of a collaboration between two or more parties to achieve a specific business goal.
Licensing Agreements Grants a licensee the rights to use intellectual property owned by the licensor.	Loan Agreements Outlines the terms for borrowing money between a lender and a borrower.	Sales Agreements Documents the sale and purchase terms of goods or assets.
Terms and Conditions Sets out the rules and regulations under which a business operates or sells its goods/services.	Outsourcing Agreements Covers the transfer of specific business processes or services to a third party.	Subcontractor Agreements Details the terms under which a subcontractor provides services or completes work for a contractor.
Share Purchase Agreement Details the sale and purchase of company shares.	Stephensons Making it easier to access legal services
