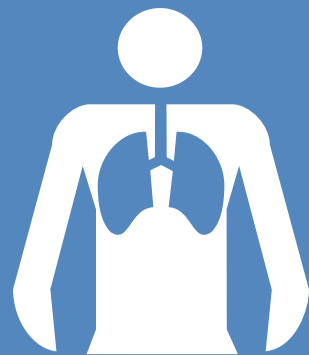


Occupational lung disease



'Lung disease' includes mesothelioma as well as a range of other respiratory cancers as well as COPD, occupational asthma, pneumoconiosis and other non-cancerous respiratory diseases.

The symptoms of most of these diseases – with the main exception of occupational asthma and other allergic respiratory disease – become apparent many years after exposure.



Sufferers identified the following factors as causing or making their ill-health worse:

20%

identified dust from stone, cement brick or concrete



13%

identified airborne materials from spray painting or manufacturing foam products



10%

identified airborne materials while welding, soldering or cutting/grinding metals



7%

identified dusts from flour, grain/cereal, animal feed or straw
